

BREITUNG TOWNSHIP BOARD
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING – CONTRACT FOR CODE ENFORCEMENT
WITH DICKINSON COUNTY SHERIFF AND COUNTY CONTROLLER
NOVEMBER 4, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Olson at 1:00 p.m.

Roll Call: Present: Trustees Rochon, Wales, Soderbloom (arrived at 1:05 p.m.), Clerk Neuens, Treasurer Taylor and Supervisor Olson.

Also present: Superintendent Mulka, Sheriff Scott Rutter and County Control Brian Bousley.

Public Comment: No comments.

Discussion on Contract for Code Enforcement/Police Services: Superintendent Mulka reviewed the changes that were made to the Contract for Police Services.

Paragraph 1: Removed the 12/31/24 contract termination date and replaced with “three years from the date of signing”.

Paragraph 2, Section 2.3: Changed the title of this section from “Start-Up Costs” to “Vehicle & Equipment Costs”.

Paragraph 4, Section 4.1: Inserted...the County agrees to provide “code enforcement of Township ordinances and” additional police protection...

Paragraph 4, Section 4.2: Inserted...the Deputy to provide “code enforcement and”...

Overall the contract seems to meet the needs of the township.

Sheriff Rutter feels this will be a great benefit to our residents and feels he has the perfect officer picked to serve as the Breitung Township Deputy.

The Contract for Police Services will be on the November 11, 2019 Regular Board Meeting agenda for discussion and approval.
