

The following are provisions that apply:

The program is available to township residents only, with proof of residency and ID required. Tax bills or utility bills are acceptable forms to prove residency. Signing in at the baler office is required.

Only tires without rims. Tires with rims brought in will require a \$10 disposal fee to be paid by the resident.

The drop-off containers are located at the Dickinson County Solid Waste Processing Facility, behind the Tri-City Cinema. Hours are 8:00 am – 3:30 pm, Monday – Friday and 9:00 am – Noon on Saturday. The collection program will begin immediately and end when the maximum grant capacity of 2,000 tires is reached.

Residents need to be prepared to handle tires at the baler facility; GAD personnel will not unload tires.

Items not accepted under this grant include: Solid tires, forklift tires, oversized tires including Semi Truck tires, Agricultural tires, etc., and any tire still on the rim. These items turned in will result in a charge to the resident, not to the grant program.

The township reserves the right to modify or end this program at any time.
