<p>ONLY <u>Plastic #1 and #2</u></p> <p>SEPARATE: 1. MILK JUGS 2. COLORED #2 3. PET #1</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • #1 (PET) and #2 (HDPE) containers only (look on bottom of container) • Rinse well • Remove rings and caps, put in garbage • If possible, remove label 	<p>NO!!!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • #1 Non-bottle items (bakery, produce, meat containers or trays) • #2 motor oil or antifreeze containers • Plastic with codes #3 through #7 NO OIL CONTAINERS!!! NO PLASTIC BAGS!!! NO ANTIFREEZE CONTAINERS!!!
<p>Glass Bottles and jars (clear, brown and green)</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse well • Do not break • Remove/discard all caps or lids • Peel labels if possible 	<p>NO!!!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plate windows • Light bulbs • Mirrors • Clay pots • Glassware • Ceramics
<p>Aluminum, steel and bi-metal cans</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse well • Empty, clean dried-out paint cans and lids • Aluminum pie plates • Separate aluminum 	<p>NO!!!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Loose lids, covers or caps • No dirty foil
<p>Newsprint Magazines Cardboard Office/mixed paper</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep dry • Separate newsprint • Flatten cardboard • Remove plastic liners 	<p>NO!!!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tissue products • Contaminated paper • Juice boxes • Milk cartons • Wax coated boxes • Food contaminated papers

GAD/Dickinson County Recycling Program

DICKINSON COUNTY RESIDENTS ONLY

The GAD/Dickinson County Recycling program is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., and 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Saturday. Please observe the guidelines. Gate is "locked" promptly at closing time. DO NOT GET LOCKED IN!!!

COMPOSTING GUIDELINES

Leaves and other vegetation only (grass clippings) may be brought to the designated compost area. DO NOT LEAVE ANY PLASTIC BAGS!!! Dump in designated compost area only. Watch for signs. Finished compost is free to Dickinson County residents for home use. ABSOLUTELY NO BRUSH OR TREE LIMBS ALLOWED!!!

SCRAP METAL GUIDELINES

Large and small metal items are accepted at the facility. White goods are accepted only with certificate of freon removal. Most other materials are accepted. No item with hazardous materials will be accepted!!! No fluorescent light fixtures with ballast. ABSOLUTELY NO GAS TANKS!!!

USED OIL, BATTERIES AND TIRES

Used oil is accepted at the facility. Pour used oil into brown designated storage tanks inside of processing building. NO CONTAMINATED OIL IS ACCEPTED!!! Take your used oil container with you to use again or dispose of the container as waste. The used oil container is not recyclable.

Tires are accepted at a fee depending on size.

Automobile batteries are to be placed in designated area.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household hazardous waste is accepted free by appointment only. The following list of material is accepted: enamel and oil based paint, paint thinners, solvents, antifreeze, pesticides and other hazardous materials. Materials not accepted are: biohazards, explosives, latex paint, radioactive waste. Please call 774-5680 for an appointment or if you have any questions.
