

# 7 FAQ's about Voting and Voting Registration

## 1. Where do I register to vote?

You can register to vote at your local clerk's office, county clerk's office, or at any Secretary of State Branch office. If you are registering less than 15-days before an election, you must register to vote at your local clerk's office. **3851 Menominee Street, Quinnesec, MI 49876. 906-779-2050.**

## 2. When is the last day to register to vote by mail? 15-days before an election.

To register by mail, complete the [Michigan Voter Registration Application](#) and mail to your township clerk at least 15-days before the election. **Breitung Township Clerk, P.O. Box 160, Quinnesec, MI 49876.**

## 3. When is the last day to register in person? 8pm on Election Day.

Anyone who wishes to register to vote less than 15-days before an election, including on Election Day, must register in person your township clerks' office.

## 4. Who can vote by mail? Everyone can vote by mail!

To request a ballot, complete the [Michigan Absent Voter Ballot Application](#) and mail to your township clerk. **Breitung Township Clerk, P.O. Box 160, Quinnesec, MI 49876.** Ballots are available for 45-days prior to every election.

## 5. How do I vote by mail for every election?

To receive an absentee ballot application for every election, ask your township clerk about joining the Permanent Absentee Voter List. **3851 Menominee Street, Quinnesec, MI 49876. 906-779-2050.**

## 6. When can I vote by mail?

Absentee ballots are available 45-days before every election. You can request to have a ballot mailed to you up until 5pm on the Friday before the election. You can also request a ballot in person at township clerk's office until 4pm on the Monday before the election. New voters can pick up an absentee ballot in person when they register to vote at the township clerk's office until 8pm on Election Day. **All ballots must be returned to the township clerk no later than 8pm on Election Day.**

## 7. Can I register to vote at my polling place? No.

If you are not registered to vote on Election Day, you must register to vote at your township clerk's office. **3851 Menominee Street, Quinnesec, MI 49876.** However, you may vote an absentee ballot at your township clerk's office when you register to vote or you can take your registration receipt and vote in person at your polling place.
